**New Medication Guide to be Released for Parents on Treating
Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)**

Tuesday, October 2, 2007 at 11:00 A.M. (ET)

Washington, DC – On October 2 during a teleconference news briefing, the American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry (AACAP) and the American Psychiatric Association (APA) will jointly announce the release of a new ADHD medication guide for parents. The guide will provide information on symptoms, treatment options, types of medications, side effects, and co-occurring disorders.
